Our Food Drive supported: Haven Center in Lorain which is the only 24/7 homeless shelter for families in Lorain County; St. Paul's UCC which is our sister church in Ohio City, Cleveland; Avon Lake CRS (Community Resource Services) that serves our residents who are suddenly in need of emergency assistance; Mercy Resource Mothers in Lorain who support new, single expecting mothers through their pregnancy and their baby's first year; and Assist Communities with support of Primary Purpose and Margeau's House (male and female rehab homes respectively). 
